Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham will conduct **the seat allotment online**, through a Centralised Seat Allotment Process [CSAP] for admission to its B.Tech. programmes offered at Amrita School of Engineering at **Amaravati, Amritapuri, Bengaluru, Coimbatore, Chennai, Faridabad, Haridwar and Nagercoil** campuses for the academic year 2026-27. There is no need for the candidates to physically visit any of the respective campuses to participate in the Amrita B.Tech **Centralised Seat Allotment Process [CSAP]**. Processes in Amrita B.Tech CSAP viz. Registration, Seat Allotment and Fee Payment are completely online. Login to aeee.amrita.edu and click on the CSAP Registration button to start the process. Eligibility Criteria

Age: Candidates born on or after 1st July 2005.

Educational Qualification: A pass in 10 + 2 (Class XII) or its equivalent examination with minimum **60% aggregate** of marks in **Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry** with not less than **50%** in each of these three subjects – **Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics individually**.

Selection procedure

Candidates should have Amrita Entrance Examination – Engineering (AEEE) 2026 Rank / JEE Mains 2026 Percentile as seat allotment is fully based on the rank secured by the candidate in AEEE 2026 / JEE Mains 2026 Percentile (Candidates need to enter their highest percentile in JEE Mains 2026 if there are two scores from two sessions).

Allocation of Seat:

AEEE 2026 : 70% of the Seat allotment

JEE Mains 2026 : 30% of the Seat allotment

A candidate can choose to apply either through AEEE 2026 Rank or JEE Mains 2026 Percentile Score individually or even select both. Allotment will be made taking into consideration the best rank among both.

Hostel Fee will be updated along with the first allotment.

Differential fee structure is applied based on the rank scored in Amrita Entrance Examination - Engineering (AEEE) 2026 or JEE Mains 2026 percentile to ensure that meritorious candidates receive the scholarship benefit. The fees in subsequent years will be based on the academic performance of the candidate i.e. CGPA, at the end of every academic year **as per the terms and conditions for award and renewal of scholarship framed by the University**. This is to ensure that the candidate admitted under a low fee slab maintains strong academic performance thereby improving opportunities for placements in top companies.

Terms & Conditions for the Renewal of the Scholarship

Scholarship Fee Slab 1, 2, 3 allotted will be for the first academic year (2026-27) only.

Renewal of scholarship Fees for subsequent years is subject to meeting the following conditions:

Candidates allotted in Slab 1

1. Consistent Academic performance by securing a **Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 7.0 at the end of each academic year**
2. No disciplinary action during the period of study in the University.
3. Clearing each semester without any arrear

Failing to meet the aforesaid conditions 1, 2 and 3 the candidate will be required to pay the fees of the applicable Slab based on CGPA **in the subsequent years**.

- If Slab 1 Student maintains CGPA 7.0 and above, the same fees slab will continue.
- If his/her CGPA is between 6.5 and 7.0, he/she will pay Slab 2 fees in the subsequent year.
- If his/her CGPA is between 6.0 and 6.5, he/she will pay Slab 3 fees in the subsequent year.
- If his/her CGPA is below 6.0, he/she will pay Slab 4 fees in the subsequent year.

Candidates allotted in Slab 2

1. Consistent Academic performance by securing a **Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 6.5 at the end of each academic year**
2. No disciplinary action during the period of study in the University.
3. Clearing each semester without any arrear

Failing to meet the aforesaid conditions 1, 2 and 3 the candidate will be required to pay the fees of the applicable Slab based on CGPA **in the subsequent years**.

- If Slab 2 Student maintains CGPA 6.5 and above, the same fees slab will continue.
- If his/her CGPA is between 6.0 and 6.5, he/she will pay Slab 3 fees in the subsequent year.

➤ If his/her CGPA is below 6.0, he/she will pay Slab 4 fees in the subsequent year.

Candidates allotted in Slab 3

1. Consistent Academic performance by securing a **Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 6.0 at the end of each academic year**
2. No disciplinary action during the period of study in the University.
3. Clearing each semester without any arrear

Failing to meet the aforesaid conditions 1, 2 and 3 the candidate will be required to pay the fees of the applicable Slab based on CGPA **in the subsequent years.**

➤ If Slab 3 Student maintains CGPA 6.0 and above, the same fees slab will continue. ➤

If his/her CGPA is below 6.0, he/she will pay Slab 4 fees in the subsequent year.

In the event a student moves to higher fee slab due to not meeting conditions 1, 2 and 3 above, the student will not be able to move back to the old slab even if his/her CGPA improves in further subsequent years.

Centralised Seat Allotment Process [CSAP] Procedure

Registration:

Candidates desiring to join Amrita B.Tech programme shall participate in CSAP. Candidates are allowed to register for CSAP only once, at the beginning of each round. Registration will be opened after the publication of AEEE 2026 ranks, and after each round of allotment. Registration process for CSAP starts by logging in with your Registered E-Mail ID/Mobile No. verified during the application submission. All the important communications will be only through the registered mobile number and e-mail ID. **All further CSAP processes will be possible only after OTP validation.**

Note: Multiple CSAP registrations from a candidate will not be considered. Candidates cannot claim refund of the Registration fees paid for multiple registrations.

Candidates are required to complete the following mandatorily in the CSAP portal to complete CSAP registration. The relevant documents must be available digitally while completing the registration.

- ❖ **HSC Mark Entry:** Enter the HSC marks and upload the relevant mark statement in the CSAP portal. [Make sure to check the eligibility as mentioned in this document].
- ❖ **State Boards of Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana:** Students who have completed their 12th - grade education under these state boards are required to enter their hall ticket number to retrieve their marks.
- ❖ **CBSE:** It is mandatory for students to obtain marks through DigiLocker. Please follow the steps provided in the following link to retrieve your marks: <https://csap.amrita.edu/digi12>
- ❖ **All other state boards:** You are required to upload your 12th class marks certificate and enter the marks accordingly.
- ❖ **Entering JEE Mains Score:** Enter the JEE Mains 2026 percentile (highest in case there are two scores from two sessions) and upload the relevant score card. This is applicable to candidates applying with JEE Mains 2026 percentile.

Submit academic preferences: Academic preference means combination of any campus and a B.Tech branch offered in that campus. For e.g. Faridabad Campus – Artificial Intelligence & Data Sciences.

Note: Admission will be cancelled at any stage in the CSAP process if any discrepancy is found in the data entered or not meeting the eligibility criteria or error/mismatch in the mark statement/score card uploaded in the CSAP portal.

Ensure that the +2 State, Social status – General/SC/ST/OBC/Others displayed in the CSAP portal is correct, after logging in. Both will impact your chances of admission. Upload the relevant documents, fill the academic preferences and pay the registration fees.

SC/ST Candidates are required to specify and upload the relevant Community Certificate in the CSAP portal. The Community Certificate should be in English. If the community certificate is in a language other than English, an English version certified by Notary Public should be uploaded.

E-Mail to btech@amrita.edu for any discrepancy noticed in any of the data displayed in the portal.

- Registration fee is **Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five thousand only)** and is **NON-REFUNDABLE** if the candidate is offered an admission in any of the allotment rounds of CSAP.
- Registration fee is refundable only if the candidate fails to get any of the academic preferences submitted even in the Mop Up round of CSAP (First, Second and Mop Up rounds of allotment).
- **Registration fees will not be refunded if a candidate is not exercising the options during the CSAP even after offering an admission.**
- Registration does not guarantee a seat or admission.

A certain percentage of seats are earmarked for candidates who have studied HSC in the same state for two years in Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Karnataka, Delhi-NCR, and Uttarakhand, for admission to the campuses located in these respective states.

A candidate shall enter at least one Academic Preference. A candidate can submit a maximum number of 60 academic preferences - 8 (campuses) and 20 (Branches) totally 60 academic preferences. Repetitions are NOT allowed.

Candidates are instructed to indicate **only their preferred branches** of study as “Academic Preferences” and not submit those preferences which the candidate is not interested / or just for the sake of indicating.

Academic preference(s) once submitted can be changed only after the publication of trial allotment and within the notified dates. Further change is possible only if admission is not offered during the allotment in CSAP.

A candidate along with the submission of academic preferences also need to submit the fees slab acceptable to be paid for each academic and campus preferences. Fees Slab available in the dropdown menu in the application portal will be from Fees Slab 3 to Fees Slab 5. Fee Slab 1 and 2 are part of Scholarship Fees and will be allotted automatically.

Example of academic preference submission: – Campus, Branch, Fee Slab needs to be chosen at the time of registration.

1. Amaravati CSE Fee Slab 4
2. Amritapuri CSE Fee Slab 3
3. Chennai CSE Fee Slab 4
4. Haridwar CSE Fee Slab 3

For e.g. A candidate has indicated Amaravati, CSE. Candidate must indicate the maximum fee slab up to which he/she is willing to be considered.

The candidate will not be allotted beyond the indicated fee slab even if the academic preference is available.

For e.g. If the candidate opting CSE in Amritapuri Campus has indicated fees slab upto 3 for this academic preference, then the candidate will not be allotted beyond fees slab 3 even if this academic preference is available for allotment for this candidate.

Candidates can download the Academic preferences and the indicated fees Slab submitted in PDF, after paying the CSAP Registration fees.

Allotment Procedure

Trial Allotment:

- Trial allotment is published for the candidates to understand the possibility of getting the highest academic preference.
- Login with the Registered E-Mail ID / Mobile No. Candidate will receive OTP in the registered mobile number to check the trial allotment.
- Trial allotment does not guarantee admission or the allotment of same academic preference in the first allotment, since candidates are allowed to change the academic preferences after the publication of trial allotment.
- Candidates are allowed to change the academic preferences within the stipulated dates.

Provision to change academic preferences will be closed within one day of the publication of trial allotment. Requests to change academic preferences will not be entertained after this date. It is advised to keep a printed copy of all the academic preferences submitted in case if the same has been changed.

Allotment Rounds

There are **3 (Three) rounds of allotment** in CSAP (Counselling).

Vacancy based allotment beyond mop-up round will be posted on the website and intimated to candidates by email & message. Candidates are required to visit our website for regular updates. As the seat allotment is fully based on the AEEE 2026 Rank or JEE Mains 2026 Percentile, a candidate will fall under one of the three categories shown below

Round 1 – 1st Allotment

After releasing the first allotment, there will be two types of candidates:

1. Candidates allotted in one of the Academic Preferences in the fee slab submitted

(a) Candidates allotted their Academic Preference 1 and in Fee Slab 1

***For example:** A candidate is allotted 1st Academic Preference in Fee Slab 1 and is satisfied with this allotment.*

OR

(b) Candidates allotted any one of the Academic Preferences in the Fee Slab 1 and is satisfied with the academic preference.

***For example:** A candidate is allotted 5th Academic Preference in Fee Slab 1 and is satisfied with this allotment.*

*These candidates may **“ACCEPT”** the allotment by paying initial partial tuition fee and **“CONFIRM”** the admission offer by paying the remaining fees and caution deposit on or before*

the specified dates, failing which the admission offer will stand cancelled. Such candidates are not required to attend the further rounds of CSAP as the admission is confirmed after paying the full fees.

(c) Candidates allotted one of the Academic Preferences other than the first one & in Fee Slab other than 1st.

For example: A candidate is allotted 5th academic preference in fee slab 2, 3, 4 or 5.

There are two options for these candidates

“ACCEPT” by paying initial partial tuition fee of Rs. 1 lakh and wait for the upcoming rounds to get the higher academic preference through **“UPGRADE”**.

“ACCEPT” by paying initial partial tuition fee of Rs. 1 lakh and **“CONFIRM”** by paying the remaining fees. Such candidates will be considered for a lower fee slab in the academic preference already allotted.

Once upgraded to higher academic preference in the upcoming rounds, **“CONFIRM”** the allotment and admission by paying full fees then exit from the CSAP.

2. Candidates who didn't get any allotment in the first round

Candidates who are not allotted in the first round can change their academic preferences and wait for the second round. CSAP registration for new candidates who have not registered earlier will resume after the first round of allotment and will close two days prior to the second allotment.

Round 2 – 2nd Allotment

Three categories of candidates are eligible to participate in the CSAP Second allotment:

- 1. Candidates who “ACCEPTED” the allotment by paying initial partial tuition fees of 1 lakh in the first allotment**
- 2. Candidates who have registered for CSAP after the publication of the first allotment**
- 3. Candidates who were not allotted any academic preference in the first allotment**

Candidates who are allotted in the second round shall pay the remaining/full fees, as applicable, within the specified date failing which the admission offered will stand cancelled and will be out of the CSAP process. A candidate is automatically considered for upgrade in the Mop-up rounds if opted, after paying the tuition fees.

NOTE:

- If there is no change in the allotment in the second allotment, the allotted academic preference in the first round will be retained.

Academic preference once allotted cannot be changed to a lower priority.

For example, if a candidate is allotted 5th academic preference, the candidate won't be moved to lower priority preferences such as 6 or 7.

Allotment will stand cancelled if a candidate who has been allotted any one of the academic preferences fails to pay the initial partial tuition fee / full fees, as applicable, within the stipulated date. These candidates will not be considered in subsequent rounds of CSAP.

Initial Partial tuition fee will be refunded if the candidate fails to pay the balance fees after the completion of all the rounds of counselling. Candidates are required to submit formal request in this regard. In such circumstances, the candidate cannot claim the allotted preference under the pretext of paying the fees on a later date.

Mop Up Round Allotment:

Terms and conditions for Mop Up round, if there are vacancies, will be notified on the website after the last date to pay full fees for those who got allotment in all the previous rounds. Candidates who are not offered an admission even after the mop-up round allotment will have to wait to see if there are vacancies arising in any of the branches. Allotted Candidates who have paid full fees and caution deposit will only be considered for upgradation in the Mop Up round of counselling, if there are vacancies.

Difference of fees to be paid, if any, due to the upgradation / change of preference within campus / branch / fee slab effected will have to be paid within the specified date.

Difference of fees to be reimbursed, if any, due to the upgradation/change of preference in campus / branch / fee slab effected will be reimbursed after the completion of counselling process (First, second and Mop-Up rounds) or adjusted against the next year's fees.

There will be no UPGRADE after the Mop Up Round Allotment.

If a candidate has not been allotted any of the academic preferences submitted:

- ❖ Registration fees paid will be refunded in case of those candidates who are not offered at least one of their academic preferences till the last round (Mop Up round) of seat allotment.
- ❖ Registration money will be refunded only after the completion of the last round (Mop Up round) of allotment.
- ❖ These candidates can change the academic preferences already submitted at the time of each round of registration.
